SALARY: \$17.63 PER HOUR

Per the HHSC Board of Director's executive order, the hourly rate reflects a temporary 5% hourly reduction effective April 1, 2010.

DUTIES: The Per Diem Certified Nurse Aide works in a hospital or community health unit and is responsible for providing direct patient care through the performance of a variety of nursing support tasks in accordance with established methods and procedures. The position may work on rotating shifts and in a variety of care units. Position is exempt from Civil Service.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- **Work Experience:** One (1) year of work experience in a health facility such as a hospital or similar medically oriented institution where the primary or basic objective is to observe and report on a variety of physical and/or mental symptoms and conditions and implement care and/or treatment procedures for a caseload of patients. Such experience must have demonstrated knowledge of basic nursing skills; first aid; patients rights; universal precautions; infection control; body mechanics; principles of growth and development; purpose and benefits of activities of daily living; purpose and benefits of restorative care; basic medical and nursing terminology; and the ability to assist and participate in the activities of the treatment team; assess each patient's age-specific needs; and independently provide age-specific direct personal care services to a caseload of patients.
- **Certification:** Applicants must obtain a valid State of Hawaii Nurse Aide Certificate which demonstrates knowledge of basic nursing skills; the aging process; first aid; patient rights; universal precautions; infection control; body mechanics; purpose and benefit of activities of daily living; purpose and benefits of restorative care; and basic medical and nursing terminology.

Certification in Health Care Provider (adult, child and infant) and/or Health Saver Plus (adult) must be obtained within six (6) months of employment.
